THE CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

Every 6 years the Church Electoral Roll has to be revised and this year is when that has to happen. In order to continue as a voting member of the church it is necessary for you to register by completing a short form. This year the Queen will be handing out Maundy Money to pensioners from Oxfordshire, Berkshire and Buckinghamshire at Christ Church Cathedral, Oxford. Each year the Monarch visits a UK cathedral or abbey to give out Maundy coins to elderly people in recognition of their service to their community and church – 87 men and 87 women are invited by Buckingham Palace (the figure being equal to the Queen's age).
