NEWS AND EVENTS:

THE REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY SERVICE. Thank you to Edward Maley who kindly made all the arrangements for this service. The collection for **The Poppy Appeal** raised £450, of which just over £300 was given under the Gift Aid scheme.

All proceeds to the running costs of the church. **THE PCC MEETING, 5th November.** A large part of the meeting was devoted to items of Mission in the church – discussion took place on the recently held and forthcoming Family Services; a report on the Youth Cafe was received from Marco Loxley; items re High Ash School and Christmas services and events were discussed. An update was given on the proposed change to the Pattern of Services (see item below). The charities to be supported through our Outside Giving were agreed.

THE CHANGE TO THE PATTERN OF SERVICES. At the recent Wardens' Meeting it was agreed that the pattern of services be discussed at the Wardens and PCC Meetings in January, with the hope that any **change would be implemented in March**.

From the comments received for Great Brickhill, it was clear that the Prayer Book Service of Holy Communion (currently on the first Sunday of the month) should continue on one of the two weeks when the Rector will not be committed to taking the service.

There were also a number of requests that Evensong should continue – however there was a feeling that Evensong should not be held in the winter months (January and February).

The Rector and Wardens are going to draw up a timetable for the services for the year, for what is currently the Second Sunday of the month.

It was decided that for the first two months of the New Year Evensong will not be held. There will be a service of Morning Worship on 12th January and on 9th February the Prayer Book Service of Mattins will be held.
