Servant Girl 1 & 2 / Pilate's Wife: Renu Tribhuvan

<u>The congregation</u> is asked to read the group voices (the relevant lines are highlighted in the sheets that will be handed out):-

Pulpit side: Bystanders; Passers-by; Witnesses; Soldiers; Crowd

Lectern side: Priests; Disciples; Crowd

The congregation is asked to remain seated while the Passion is being read.
