#### ACCIDENT IN THE RINGING ROOM

As some of you might already know, sadly, there was an accident in the Ringing Room in August 2010. The novice bell ringer who suffered an injury brought a claim for negligence against the PCC and our Tower Captain, David Middleton. The PCC denied liability, supported by our insurers. The matter was dealt with at a hearing in the County Court on Thursday.

The Judge found that there was no negligence. In his summing up the Judge said that there are sometimes accidents without any fault, and this was one of those occasions. We are not required to pay any costs or financial penalty.

Much of the burden in facing and seeing off this claim fell on the shoulders of David. The PCC want you all to know how grateful we are for David's commitment to our Church and to bell ringing in Great Brickhill and for managing a difficult time with such fortitude.
