The Christmas Services:-

Thank you to all those who helped with the preparation or took part in the services - the organists, choir, bell ringers, readers, and those who decorated the church so beautifully. All three services were very well attended. The Village Nativity was very successful - starting at the bottom of Pound Hill the large crowd, many dressed in nativity attire, sang their way to a short service in the church where the Nativity Scene was set. Many thanks go to the children

for their participation, with the readings and the prayers. There was as usual standing room only for the traditional Christmas Eve Carol Service – thanks to the choir for their wonderful singing and to all the readers. On Christmas morning we celebrated the birth of Christ in our special Christmas Day Holy Communion Service.

The Christmas Fundraising Events:-

The Christmas Fair was highly successful. With money received after the event the total raised has now reached £1941.10.

Carol Singing around the village raised £368 towards general church funds.

Our Christmas Charity Appeal was for the Christian Aid DEC Ebola Crisis Appeal, a joint appeal by the Disaster Emergency Committee to support the fight against the spread of Ebola and to provide medical support to those communities in need of our help. A total of £660 has been raised, including £590 from the Charity Songs of Praise, plus proceeds from the Christmas Card Tree.

Sponsor a Light in aid of church funds has raised £105. Thank you to Emily Hudson for transcribing the dedications into the Commemoration Book. Thanks also to Michael and Julia Turner for providing the tree and to Stephen Agambar for erecting it and setting up the outdoor lights.
