THEFT OF LEAD:

Unfortunately last week we had another theft of lead - virtually all the lead was stripped from the south aisle roof and more strips were taken from the north side. Permission has subsequently been granted to install an alarm system to the roof – Julia had done her utmost to expedite matters so that the alarm could have been fitted in September but the approval was not forthcoming. There is now so little lead left that we will not be going ahead with the roof alarm. We have to thank our roofing contractor for working very hard to do a temporary repair to make the roof water tight. We will be doing the permanent repair in a substitute material, not replacing the lead.

THE VIVALDI AND MESSIAH CONCERT held in the church last month was a huge success. The audience was treated to a wonderful performance. Thanks go to the musicians, the soloists and the choir, and of course to Jerry for masterminding the whole performance. The evening raised £1530 for Willen Hospice.

STONE WORK:
