NEWS AND EVENTS:

CHURCH ROOF:

Unfortunately the recent rain has been coming into the church. The roofing contractor came on Monday afternoon to secure the felt, but with the high winds that evening and on Tuesday, the same thing happened again with the rain pouring down the walls and soaking the south aisle. We had been advised that the temporary repair to the roof should last for at least two years, which would give us plenty of time to fund raise and make arrangements for the permanent repair work. As Great Brickhill is very exposed at the top of a hill the worry is that, with only a temporary cover, the roof will continually leak and cause much damage to the fabric of the church. We are now looking at bringing forward the permanent repair and are in discussion with the DAC as to how we might expedite the process, to minimise any delay which will inevitably result in further damage to the fabric of the church.

Many of you will have enjoyed the delicious local honey that Andrew Beer has kindly been supplying St Mary's for the past 19 years - the proceeds of the sale of the honey has helped to raise funds for projects and maintenance of our church.
