Unfortunately during the recent storms the rain came into the church, particularly in the south aisle. We had been advised that the temporary repair to the roof should last for at least two years, which would give us plenty of time to fund raise and make arrangements for the permanent repair work. As Great Brickhill is very exposed at the top of a hill the worry is that, with only a temporary cover, the roof will continually leak and cause much damage to the fabric of the church. We are now looking at possibly bringing forward the permanent repair and are in discussion with the DAC as to how we might proceed to minimise further damage to the fabric of the church.
