If you are unable to attend you can still take part in the Auction; advance bids will be received and given on your behalf at the Auction. Please complete the relevant section of the Ticket Application Form.

Receipt of the promises a week before the event will be much appreciated. A Catalogue of the Promises will be drawn up and circulated, via e-mail where possible, in advance of the event.
