The 9 lessons tell the story of the birth of Jesus from the very beginning (The fall of mankind from God's grace in the story of Adam and Eve) through the prophecies of his birth to his birth and after as told in the Gospels. Our normal third Sunday service which will be led by Jeremy Hopkinson


