REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY, 11th NOVEMBER:

It was good to see nearly 200 people in the church to commemorate 100 years since the Armistice Day in November 1918. Wreaths were laid by Edward Maley on behalf of the servicemen and Chris Leech for the Parish Council. Mary Smit laid the wreath made by members of the WI and a wreath was also laid by two pupils from High Ash School. The collection at the service raised £719 for The Poppy Appeal.
