Social/fundraising events including the Plant Fayre, Snowdrop Walks, Advent Coffee Morning and craft stalls, Ladies who Lunch, Happy Cup Coffee Club, Concerts, Carol Singing

6 Voluntary Activities:

You could volunteer for activities including bell ringing, singing in the choir, cleaning, lawn mowing, fundraising, catering (tea and coffee after church or other events)

5 Meetings:
