


With simple text and bright illustrations, this book provides a great overview of the Bible stories in easy manageable sections that young children can understand.






Based on the Lord's Prayer, this book helps young children think about how to talk to God and shares the message of His awesome love.



Recommended age: 4-6


This book tells favourite Bible stories in language children can easily understand with easy to read text and vibrant art making the stories come to life.

Recommended age: 4-7


This book introduces children to fifty Bible stories in engaging and age-appropriate language, brought to life by beautiful illustrations.

Recommended age: 4-7


This books shares well-known and well-loved stories from the Bible in easy to read retellings with bright and colourful illustrations.

Recommended age: 4-8


This book helps children understand they are all special in God's eyes through the story of Eli the woodcarver who helps Punchinello understand how special he is - no matter what other Wemmicks may think.

Recommended age: 4-8








When God Made You by Matthew Turner

Recommended age: 5-8


This book inspires children to learn about their own special gifts and how they fit into God's divine plan and offers them the assurance that they are deeply loved and a unique creation in our big universe.

This book helps children see how all people are valuable to God and how Jesus came to rescue all kinds of people. There is an accompanying activity book available.




A captivating retelling of the Christmas story showing how God kept His promise to send a new King. There is an accompanying activity book available.

Recommended age: 6-9


Eight Bible stories are depicted in comic cartoon illustrations with details to spot, mistakes to find and questions to answer along the sides of the picture.
