Welcome to our service of Holy Communion this morning led by the Rector. Although there can be no singing due to the restrictions, we are very pleased that Jerry Breslin will be playing the organ at various points throughout the service.

The readings for this morning are:-

Jonah 3: 10 - 4: 11; Matthew 20: 1-16

As last month certain things will be a little different from normal:-

- Hand sanitizing will be required on entry to the church.
- Please collect a single-use service sheet, gift aid envelope and pen. The envelopes/collection should then be placed in the plate on the table in the cross aisle, along with the pen before the start of the service.
- Please take the single-use service sheet and this Pew Sheet home.
- Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules.
- It is not possible to use the **pew kneelers** and seating is restricted to those pews where there the pew kneelers have been removed.
- Masks are a mandatory requirement.
- We will be asking for **contact details** of all those attending, which we have to keep for 21 days.

The Rector will be explaining the various changes that are required as we go through the service.

NEXT SUNDAY, 27th SEPTEMBER is our Harvest Festival at Rectory Farm. The service at 11.00am will be in an open barn, or outside, depending on the current restrictions (which are subject to change) and the weather. After the service all are invited to stay for a bring your own picnic. Please note the following:

- You can either walk or drive to the farm there will be plenty of parking available
- On arrival contact details will be taken and kept for 21 days
- The "Group of Six" rule will be in place
- Please bring a mask with you in case these are required, dependent upon the exact location
- Please bring your own sanitizer, chair, drink and picnic

If you are coming to the service, it would be really helpful, if at all possible, if you could please let either Julia or Phillipa know in advance, so that we know the number attending and can make sure that all the necessary precautions are taken.
