CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) OUTBREAK Update 26th September 2020

NEWS OF LIVE SERVICES:

You will know that tomorrow's Harvest Service is now being held in the church. Due to COVID-19 developments this week it is with regret that we had to change the venue of the service to the church.

We know that this news will be disappointing to many of you who were looking forward to coming to the service and enjoying a picnic in the field afterwards. We are also aware that it seems strange to be holding an indoor service rather than outside but different regulations apply for services inside a place of worship.

As for our recent services, in order to adhere to the guidelines and to keep people COVID safe:-

- Hand sanitizing will be required on entry to the church.
- Single-use service sheets will be used
- Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules and the rule of six
- Masks are a mandatory requirement.
- We will be asking for contact details, which we have to keep for 21 days.

NEXT SATURDAY we are delighted that, after many difficult months of planning, the wedding of Sarah Amies and Rob O'Connor will take place in the church. This week's restrictions have unfortunately halved the number of guests to only 15. We send our best wishes to them for a long and happy life together.

NEXT SUNDAY, 4th OCTOBER will be the Harvest Festival at Stoke Hammond. The service be at 11.00am.

OCTOBER SERVICES:

The pattern of services for the foreseeable future will continue with generally one service each week in one of the four churches in the Benefice. The schedule of services for October can be found at the end of this Newsletter.

There will be occasional virtual services to cater for those who do not yet feel able to venture out to church. We will continue to share information about the weekly virtual worship opportunities that are being either televised or live streamed from around the
