CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) OUTBREAK Update 16th October 2020

NEWS OF LIVE SERVICES:

There are two services in the Benefice this Sunday:

- A short service of Holy Communion at 9.00am at Stoke Hammond in celebration of St Luke's Day.
- A Harvest Family Service at 11.00am in Little Brickhill.

NEXT SUNDAY, 25th OCTOBER there will be a Holy Communion service here in Great Brickhill at 11.00am. Under the current restrictions:

- There is still no congregational singing
- Hand sanitizing is required on entry to the church
- Single-use service sheets will be used
- Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules and the rule of six
- Masks are a mandatory requirement
- We ask for contact details, which we have to keep for 21 days.

VIRTUAL SERVICE OF EVENSONG ON MONDAY, 26th OCTOBER AT 7.00pm:-Jerry Breslin is arranging another online Evensong service via Zoom on Monday 26th October when the choir would normally be holding their weekly practice session. NOVEMBER SERVICES:

The schedule for the end of October and November services is on a separate file accompanying this Newsletter. The pattern of services remains generally as in previous months with one service being held at one of the churches on each of the Sundays but November has a number of special services. There will be a **Remembrance Sunday** service in each village but, in order to be COVID safe, the other three villages will have an outdoor only service. Unless the regulations change the service here will be in the church and then at the war memorial.

The annual **All Souls Service** will as usual be held at Little Brickhill, on **Sunday 1st November** at 6.00pm. This is the service in which we remember with thanksgiving our loved ones who have died, those who lived here local to us or who lived further away – an important occasion this year more than ever. **If anyone would like a candle to be lit** in memory of a loved one, please contact Julia Turner 01525 261618 <u>juliaturner.jt@icloud.com</u>

The first of our special pre-Christmas services will be held at Bow Brickhill on 29th November, an **Advent Carol Service** (with no singing) at 3.00pm.

The details for the **services over the Christmas** period have yet to be confirmed but they will have to be different from our normal pattern to conform with the COVID-19 regulations.

For those who are not yet ready to come back to services in church, there are occasional virtual services and we will continue to share information about the weekly virtual worship opportunities that are being either televised or live streamed from around the country.
