CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) OUTBREAK Update 5th December 2020

TOMORROW - SECOND SUNDAY BEFORE ADVENT:

Following the end of the lock down period, churches were allowed to re-open for worship from 2nd December. This Sunday, 6th December, the service in the Benefice will be here in Great Brickhill - a service of Holy Communion at 11.00am.

Under the current restrictions:

- There is still no congregational singing
- Hand sanitizing is required on entry to the church
- Service books will be used as they will not be used again until January
- Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules
- Masks are a mandatory requirement
- We ask for contact details, which we have to keep for 21 days.

We are now required to exhibit a QR code. If you are able to, please use this code via the NHS COVID-19 App when you enter the church.

As already mentioned, it will not be possible to hold our normal Nine Lessons and Carols on Christmas Eve. The virtual Nine Lessons and Carols with pre-recorded material filmed in the church is still at the planning stage. Details will be circulated as soon as possible.

Looking forward to services in the New Year, for at least January, there will continue to be just one service in the Benefice each week.
