SERVICES FOR CHRISTMAS EVE / CHRISTMAS DAY:

Christmas Eve Midnight Holy Communion: 11.30pm at Stoke Hammond Christmas Morning Holy Communion: 9.30am at Little Brickhill & 11am at Great Brickhill

We look forward to welcoming you on Christmas day. The restrictions for services in church remain the same even though we are now in Tier 3:- There will be no congregational singing - Hand sanitizing will be required on entry to the church – Our usual Christmas service sheets will be used as they will not be required again for many months - Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules - Masks are a mandatory requirement - We will ask for contact details, which we have to keep for 21 days.

Although we are unable to sing, our organist Jerry will be there to provide music at various points through the service.

We plan to record the Rector's Christmas sermon plus a children's story for Christmas. The link to these will be made available on Boxing Day.
