

COVID RESTRICTIONS LIFTED:

For those who were at the service here last Sunday, it was wonderful that the Covid restrictions had been formally lifted. Whilst things are not totally back to pre-pandemic times it did seem as if things are moving forward. Singing among the congregation was allowed and refreshments were served after the service in our new servery/gathering area.

Different Covid recommendations from those at Great Brickhill last week will be in place for services elsewhere in the Benefice. The Rector in consultation with the Wardens at each church will decide what is appropriate for that church, taking into account, among other things, the size of the building and the likely number in the congregation.
