With our church services returning to a weekly basis as before the pandemic, it seems the right time to discontinue these Newsletters.

BUT:

- I will continue to circulate the Rector's reflections and stories each week and short messages will be sent within the e-mail.
- The occasional PCC Newsletters will resume on an ad hoc basis, whenever there is new information to report.
- The monthly Parish Newsletters will contain details of services and upcoming events and the Parish InfoLine will also be used when required.
- The website will be updated with all the information re services etc.

REMINDER OF THE CURRENT COVID RECOMMENDATIONS FOR EACH CHURCH:

With Covid restrictions largely being lifted on 19th July, individual churches can recommend/advise/encourage certain restrictions to remain. There will be different Covid recommendations in place for services at the individual churches within the Benefice. The Rector in consultation with the Wardens at each church will decide what is appropriate for that church, taking into account, among other things, the size of the building and the likely number in the congregation.

NEXT WEEK'S SERVICE - SUNDAY, 5th SEPTEMBER:

The first week of the new service pattern:-Benefice Holy Communion here at Great Brickhill at 10.00am

OTHER SERVICES IN SEPTEMBER:

September is month 1 in the 4-month pattern. The full service schedule for September can be found at the end of this Newsletter.

A REMINDER OF THE NEW SERVICE PATTERN:

Each parish will generally have a Holy Communion service at 9.30am and a Family Service or Family Service with Holy Communion at 11.00am. The services for the third and fourth weeks will be determined at local level. If there is a fifth Sunday, this will give an opportunity to hold special different style/different venue services.

In Great Brickhill the general pattern in a normal month will be:-

1st Sunday: 9.30am Holy Communion

2nd Sunday:- Prayer Book Evensong / Mattins / occasional Holy Communion

3rd Sunday: 11.00am Family Service

4th Sunday:- No fixed service, decided on occasional ad hoc basis

There will be a monthly benefice service at one of the churches on a rotational basis at 10.00am, taking the place of the normal Holy Communion service at that church. No other service will be held in the benefice that day.

There will be changes to the above pattern to facilitate this monthly Benefice service and at certain times of the year, e.g. Easter, Harvest, Remembrance, Christmas. The pattern will be reviewed after 12 months.

For the time being, for those who are not yet ready to attend church, the weekly reflections and stories will continue.

The channel of communication used to publicise the services will be widened. Each parish is reviewing what is available to them, to maximise all possible ways of getting the information out to as many as possible.
