#### OPEN GARDENS, LAST SUNDAY AFTERNOON 3rd JULY:

Thank you to all who helped on Sunday for the Open Gardens whether opening your garden, providing the delicious cakes, helping to serve the teas or selling the ice creams. There fewer visitors than last year - the total funds raised from the Gardens Entry Fee, which is being shared equally between MK Food Bank and the Ukrainian Refugees, was £454.

The proceeds from the teas and cakes etc were in aid of the church. The amount was also down on last year:-  $\pounds$ 394 teas plus  $\pounds$ 68 ice creams (it was a bit cold for many to think about having an ice cream!). The total was  $\pounds$ 462, compared to  $\pounds$ 742 last year.

Our thanks go to the Gardening Club for again giving us the opportunity to do the teas in the church. As ever, whilst raising funds is always a good thing to do, an equally important aspect of an event such as this is providing a social occasion for people to enjoy meeting up with others from the village.
