#### Sunday 16th February 2025 – The Third Sunday before Lent

Welcome to our Family Service this morning, which will be led by Phillipa, and Jerry will be providing our music today on the piano. Do join in with the singing and use the shakers as much as you like.

We will have just one reading, the story of when Jesus went to dinner with Zacchaeus from the Storyteller Bible taken from Luke Chapter 19 verses 1-10.

The prayers will be said in sections by various members of the congregation. At the end of each section there will be a pause and then, accompanied by Jerry on the piano, we will sing a simple but moving Taizé chant. The words we will sing are:-

#### O Lord hear my prayer, O Lord hear my prayer: when I call answer me. O Lord hear my prayer, O Lord hear my prayer. Come and listen to me.

The Peace. After a verbal introduction, Jerry will sing quietly another Taizé piece "Let your soul find Peace" while the peace is being shared. The words will be:-

Let your soul find peace, may all your troubles cease. Shadows fade away, may from the night come day. Hold your memories dear, Those lost to you are near. May your sadness cease, And let your soul find peace.

Everyone is invited to stay after the service for coffee and a chat.
