20th Sunday after Trinity celebrating St Luke

The readings for this morning are:-

Isaiah 35: 3 – 6 (from the St. Luke's day readings)

Luke 24: 36 – 40 which goes with the theme of the service relating to healing - as we go through life we all have scars, and Jesus did too. Scars can remind us about times of hurt and pain, but they can also be signs of hope.

Most of the Covid recommendations have been relaxed and we will be standing to sing our hymns.
