The area will be cordoned off until remedial work has been carried out.

This morning's Holy Communion service will be led by the Rector. Unfortunately, we are still not able to sing but we are very pleased that Jerry Breslin will again be here to play the organ at various points throughout the service.

The gospel passage will be read in dramatic form. Thank you to those who have agreed to read the various parts. Everyone will be issued with a script and you are asked to please join in the words that are highlighted on your copy. Please leave the script in the pew at the end of the service.

Hand sanitizing is still required on entry to the church. Our normal red books will be used as they have not been in use for many months and will not be required again until May. The collection/envelopes should be placed in the plate on the table in the cross aisle before the start of the service. Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules. Masks are a mandatory requirement and contact details of all those attending will be kept for 21 days.
