#### SUNDAY 30th MAY 2021: TRINITY SUNDAY

Welcome to our service of Holy Communion, led by the Rector. Jerry Breslin will be with us providing music throughout the service and members of the choir will also be here, singing hymns and possibly an anthem. Sadly, congregational singing is still not allowed.
