DEFECTS WORK ON NEW FACILITIES:

The internal work to rectify the defects in the new extension and refreshment area is proceeding well. We are making sure that there will be minimum disruption during this period.

NATIONAL CHURCHES TRUST GRANT:

We have received two grants for our re-roofing project via the National Churches Trust (\pounds 5,000 from the Wolfson Foundation and \pounds 6,500 from the Headley Trust). The National Churches Trust sent out a press release this week and the MK Citizen publicized an online article, which totally misquoted the figures. We have not received \pounds 473,750 as stated in the article - that is the total shared nationally between 33 churches. The article has since been amended.

All the lead was stolen from both aisles of the church. This was particularly frustrating as we had done a full restoration of the roof costing £350k only ten years prior. Since 2016 we have had a temporary covering of felt on the roof, which is now failing and has to be replaced with a permanent covering of terne coated steel. This work will cost in the region of £128k, the exact amount being dependent upon the extent of the damage to the roof timbers and ceiling panels.

We are extremely grateful to the National Churches Trust for facilitating the two grants. We have also been successful in being awarded grants from The Benefact Trust, Bucks Historic Churches Trust, the Francis Coales Charitable Foundation and the Archdeacon's Fund, with two further grant applications to be determined. We are hopeful that by the end of the year we should have the funding in place to go ahead with the urgent repair to the church roof. As the quote in the Press Release states, it will be wonderful not to have to put out buckets each time it rains!"
